Categories and Classes

• Class 1: Cakes - Open

• Class 2: Scones

• Class 3: Biscuits

• Class 4: Junior Baker (under 12yrs) – Cakes, Scones or Biscuits

Note: All entries are eligible for the publicly voted People's Choice Award. We welcome entries that cater for dietary preferences, eg; gluten free.

People's Choice Award

All entries will be eligible for a people's choice award and entered automatically. Votes for People's Choice will be collected throughout the exhibition day. Winners will also be announced on social media after the conclusion of the Cuby GrooveFest Festival.

- Entry fee is \$5 per entry fees can be paid in person at the Shire Offices during office hours (cash or card) or cash only on event day.



Conditions of Entry

TYPE OF BAKED GOODS ACCEPTED

- Cakes
- Scones (group of 6)
- Biscuits (group of 8)

DROP OFF PROCESS

Drop off at Date & Time: Delivery of baked goods accepted in person to the CWA Hall, 183 Campbell St, Cuballing WA 6311 between 8.00am – 9.15am on Saturday 14th September 2024. Exhibition will run from 10.00am – 12.00pm. Pop-Up Café open from 8.00am – 2.00pm.

When you arrive at the Cuballing CWA Hall, our friendly team of competition stewards will be there to meet you. You'll be asked to leave your baked goods on a holding table while you confirm your registration.

You'll then be asked to prepare your baked goods for the relevant competition table, e.g. Cake, Scones or Biscuits. This will mean taking your goods out of any boxes or packaging.

You'll be asked to leave your entry on the holding tables, in the good care of our professional stewards. The stewards will then move your entry to the relevant competition tables and set it up for you.

WHAT IF MY ENTRY GETS DAMAGED IN TRANSIT?

We understand mishaps do happen from time to time. If you're entry has been damaged in transit, we'll find you a quiet place for you to sit and fix it. In the event your entry can't be fixed, don't despair! We'll give you a damaged in transit card to place with your entry.

PRESENTATION

All entries must be presented on their own Board/ plate but must not exceed more than **5cm** past the base of the item on display. We encourage the use of cleats under your Board/ plate. Cleats are unseen and designed so your entry can be lifted with ease.

JUDGING

Judging will occur between 9.30am and 10.15am.

Once judging is complete all certificates will be placed with the entries. Results, and photos will also be published on the Shire of Cuballing Website in the week commencing 16/09/2024.



PICK UP PROCEDURE

Unless requested to be placed "on display only" all entries will be available for purchase by the public as a donation to local sporting clubs.

FUNDRAISER SALES

Unless notified otherwise all baked goods will be available for resale to the public as a fundraiser for local community groups from 1pm.

Collections can occur after 1.30pm on Saturday 14th September 2024. Uncollected items will not be held.

Baked goods with cream incorporated in the recipe are unable to be onsold and must be collected by the baker by 1.45pm.
